What to drop off?

- ✓ Prescription pills and tablets
(please remove labels)
- ✓ Over the counter pills and tablets

What **NOT** to drop off?

- ✗ Needles and syringes
- ✗ Liquid medicines
- ✗ Illicit drugs...*Marijuana, cocaine, heroin etc.*

Why?

- ✓ Prescription drug abuse is a growing problem especially among teens
- ✓ Accidental poisoning from medicines are on the rise
- ✓ Medicines flushed down the drain or in the trash can contaminate water, harm wildlife, and pollute drinking water
